

How do you find the right glove size?

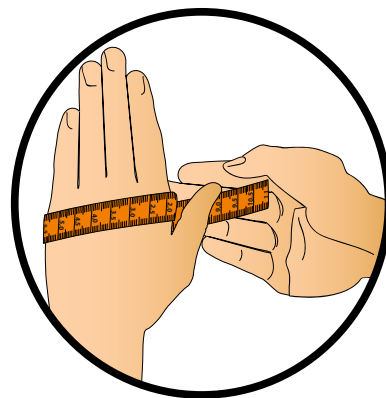
Many manufacturers use the S – M – L – XL size system for their gloves. This, however, means that it is often impossible to achieve a perfect fit:

- Problem 1: Too-small glove: Danger of cold bridges
- Problem 2: Too-big glove: Limits movement and tactility

ZIENER offers a choice of up to 11 sizes, depending on the model, ensuring that gloves fit perfectly. The international unit of measurement (sizing standard for gloves) is the inch. (1 Inch = 2,54 cm). To find out his glove size, you can cut out the template on the left.

How to measure correctly:

- Place the measuring tape around the widest part of the back of the hand (without thumb) and measure
- Inch measurement = Glove size

Tip:

Always get the customer to try the glove on! There should be a gap roughly equivalent to ½ a fingertip at the finger tips to ensure that there is enough air in the gloves and that no cold bridge can form. The motto in this regard is "better too big than too small".

As a general rule: mittens are always warmer than finger gloves!!
