How do you find the right glove size?

Many manufacturers offer gloves in sizes S, M, L, and XL. However, this often does not allow for an optimal fit.

- Problem 1: Gloves that are too small: risk of cold spots
- Problem 2: Gloves that are too large: restricted movement and grip


At ZIENER, you can choose from up to 12 sizes to find the perfect fit for you, depending on the model. The international unit of measurement (size standard for gloves) is inches (1 inch = 2.54 cm). To find out your glove size, you can cut out the measuring tape on the left.

THE ZIENER-SHAPE: Our pre-shaped cut adapts to the natural position of the hand.

The result: a noticeably better fit and greater comfort.

HOW TO MEASURE CORRECTLY:

- Place the measuring tape around the widest part of the back of your hand (excluding your thumb) and measure.
- Inch measurement = glove size



NEW: We now also offer some gloves in S-M-L sizes.

TIP: Gloves should always be tried on. There should be about half a fingertip's width of space at the fingertips to ensure that there is enough air in the gloves and no cold spots can form.

The rule of thumb is: better too big than too small.

As a general rule, mittens are always warmer than gloves!
